Only authorised staff will have access to your information which is held in a secure environment. The provision of information by you is voluntary. However, if you do not provide full information, the Law Society may not be able to progress your application. Under the Privacy Act 1993 you may request access to and request correction of your personal information held by the Law Society.
